In the identified area, the current year population is 5,871. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 5,833. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.08% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 5,753 representing a change of -0.41% annually from 2018 to 2023. Currently, the population is 47.5% male and 52.5% female.

Median Age

The median age in this area is 39.7, compared to U.S. median age of 38.3.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 1.7% of the population in the identified area compared to 18.3% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 11.4 in the identified area, compared to 64.3 for the U.S. as a whole.

Households by Income

Current median household income is \$70,542 in the area, compared to \$58,100 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$77,519 in five years, compared to \$65,727 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$89,034 in this area, compared to \$83,694 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$101,993 in five years, compared to \$96,109 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$35,100 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$31,950. The per capita income is projected to be \$40,354 in five years, compared to \$36,530 for all U.S. households

Currently, 74.9% of the 2,335 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.3%, renter occupied; and 3.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 2,324 housing units in the area - 73.8% owner occupied, 21.0% renter occupied, and 5.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.21%. Median home value in the area is \$137,609, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.64% annually to \$149,304.
