Currently, 61.4% of the 50,475 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 27.1%, renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 50,475 housing units in the area - 63.6% owner occupied, 27.3% renter occupied, and 9.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.00%. Median home value in the area is \$96,510, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.78% annually to \$110,701.
