In the identified area, the current year population is 102,135. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 103,998. The rate of change since 2020 was -0.80% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 99,374 representing a change of -0.55% annually from 2022 to 2027. Currently, the population is 48.5% male and 51.5% female.

Currently, 61.8% of the 49,495 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.9%, renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 49,727 housing units in the area and 10.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is -0.21%. Median home value in the area is \$145,336, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 8.81% annually to \$221,675.
